Electronics on Campus

It is strongly recommended that all electronic devices, which includes but is not limited to cell phones, will NOT be brought on campus. Rim High School and Rim of the World Unified School District WILL NOT be held responsible for lost or stolen items. The school does not have the time or personnel to investigate and try to recover lost/stolen items. If these items are brought to school it is the student's responsibility to care for them.

Legal Reference: EDUCATION CODE 32212

Cell Phone Policy

No warning will need to be given to students, all electronic devices (cell phones, electronic watches, tablets, etc) ***must be completely out of site, turned off, and in backpack***. If teacher decided to use devices for instructional purposes, they may allow it at specified times.

- **1st Offense** – Phone picked up by security.
Student will be called by office and given phone back during the day.
- **2nd Offense** – Phone picked up by security.
Student can pick device up at the end of the day, phone call home.
- **3rd Offense** – Phone picked up by security.
Contact home, parent must pick phone up at end of the day, lunch detention.
- **4th Offense** – Phone picked up by security.
Guardian pick up and meet with administration, lunch detention.

Note:

Administration or Teachers may request students to turn off a device and store it in backpack, purse, etc., at any time. Non-compliant students may have the phone or device held by administration until the end of the school day or until parent/guardian picks it up. Devices are to be turned "off" during ALL classroom time (unless otherwise specifically stated for ACADEMIC use by teacher).
