



Rim of the World Unified School District School Sites Accomplishments 2017-2018

CHE:

- Attendance winner during the reporting period of 2017-2018, by utilizing attendance incentives and activities, as well as regularly working the SART process in a consistent, yet supportive manner.
- Hosted 7 Title One Family Nights- "Loving Solutions" with dinner, babysitting, & Presentation provided by staff and Rim Family Services partnering.
- Upgraded technology and went to one to one devices in grades 3-5 with 6 Carts of Chrome Books.
- Reestablished our PBIS team with a new coach. We created written procedures and systems for Tier II interventions and attended trainings on Tier III provided by the county. We were approved by the county PBIS team to apply for Gold recognition from the state on May 18.
- Utilized our last year's grant from Rim Education Foundation by taking groups of students snowshoeing the day after a snowfall. This assisted with our attendance as well as providing an incredible experience!
- PTA hosted 3rd annual Tinkering Night

LAE:

- Implementing MTSS: Academics and Behavior Implementing the RtI model for academics-specifically an intervention piece in Tier 1 utilizing 2 push-in aides, as well as our kindergarten team providing Tier 2 literacy interventions grades 1-5. This includes data driven conversations, decisions, and progress monitoring.
- Developed a Safety Team, with a Safety Coordinator. Developed protocols, purchased needed safety equipment, established and adhered to a drill schedule, and partnered with local law enforcement and Fire for drills and feedback.
- Special Education Team—classified and certificated—developing our working vision and goals based on LAE's mission. This became our working norms. Supporting and collaborating one another personally and for student achievement.
- Continued implementation of Tier 1 PBIS structures—particularly the development of our Majors vs. Minors Student Discipline Flowchart, alignment of our ODR (Office Discipline Referral), alignment of our Teacher documentation of Student Intervention Report, inputting discipline in to Aeries for developing data driven decisions.



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- Development and implementation of PBIS Student Behavior Expectation Recognition System with the support of classified, certificated, and administration.
- Team building, bringing joy back in to our classrooms, and building positive relationships with colleagues, students, and parents.
