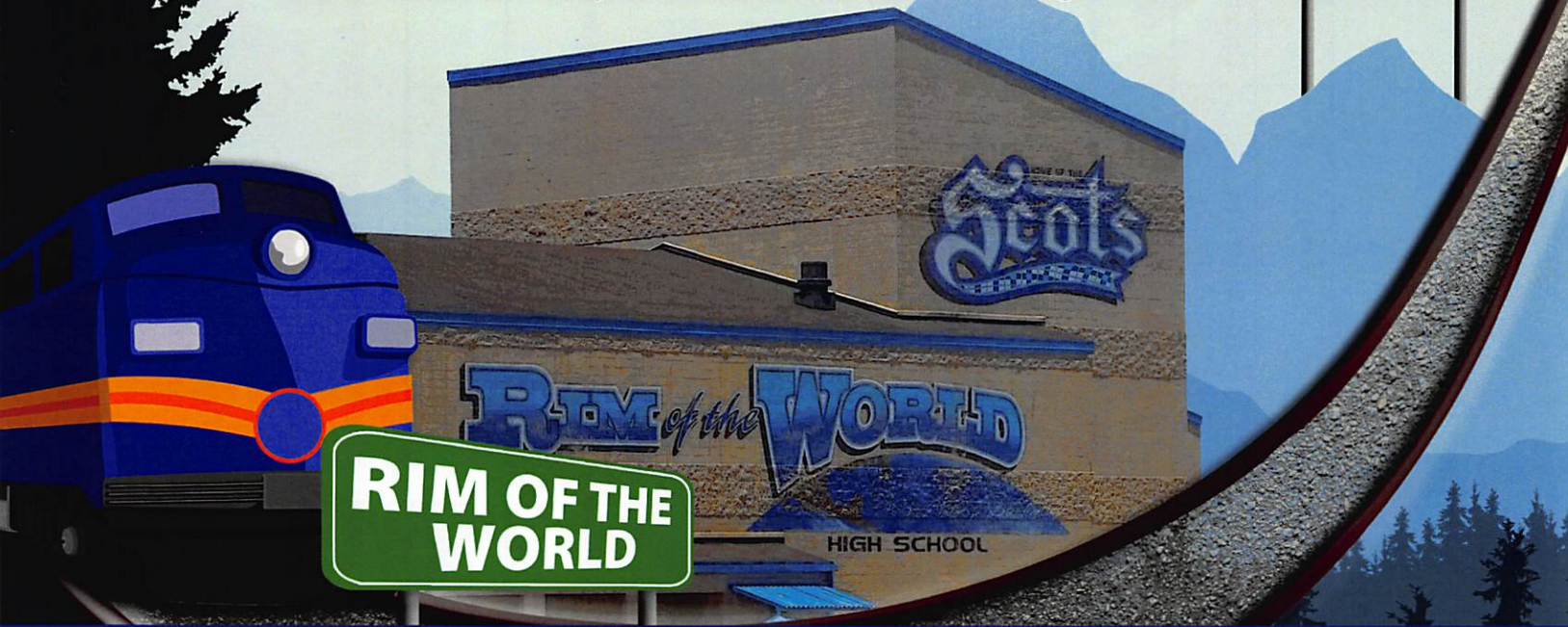


# Super Saturday One-Stop Registration Event JUNE 1, 2019
