

LTIS Program

Are you interested in a program that will partner you and your child with a Rim credentialed teacher, who will guide their lessons through the computer and grade their work? If so, Rim's "LTIS" program may be what you are looking for! Please let us know if you are seriously interested so we can plan for staffing and reserve a spot for your student.

Professional Support

Your child will work through the Odysseyware program at home on your schedule, but you will be required to meet with a credentialed teacher on a regular basis via zoom or at a school site. The teacher will schedule the meetings with you during a week day and time. It is mandatory keep these appointments. This is how attendance is monitored at the state level.

Flexibility

Your child will work through the program on their own time while following a Master Agreement that is signed by you and the district. Your student should be an independent learner to be successful in this program and should be close to grade level proficiency in all subjects. You will have to keep track of all assignments and through the Odysseyware program.

- Do you have philosophical or religious beliefs that are not promoted with public education that you would like to introduce?

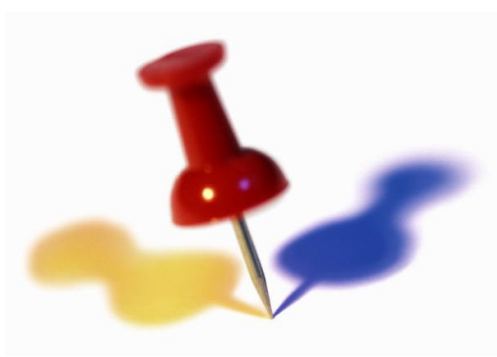

Attendance

Student and teacher will account for attendance when they meet via zoom regularly and in Google Classroom daily. The Independent Study teacher will grade the work for each student for review by the state. Missing a weekly meeting can have devastating consequences for your child's attendance so it will be a mutually agreed upon time based on teacher availability.

The calendar will follow the traditional school calendar for Rim with holidays, winter, spring, and summer breaks. You do have flexibility on when you want your child to work, including the day, evenings, and weekends.

Your child must have access to a device and the internet at home to be considered for this program.

Not in Place of Home Hospital

Your student should be an independent learner who is at or above grade level. It may be challenging for special education or certain medical needs to be addressed in a home school program, although it could be good for some conditions so let's take a look through the IEP process.

Resources

Your assigned credentialed teacher and the administrator in charge of this program will be a great resource to you in setting up schedules and helping you work through the Odysseyware program and any other questions you may have about LTIS. Don't hesitate to contact them and make sure to make your weekly meetings and make the best use of that time for you and the teacher.

Working Students

Your child may have a job and they are required to work during school hours so as long as they can make the zoom check-in daily in the morning, they can work in the OW program in the evenings or on the weekends.
