Site Accomplishments
2021-2022

CHE:

- Established a School Leadership Team (SLT) to create a team of instructional leaders to help drive instruction.
- Created a School Implementation Plan with SLT to focus on small, guided reading groups to assist in increasing ELA scores and literacy proficiency.
- Began “Fun Fridays” as a whole school structured time for students to have fun while learning life skills such as cooking, providing STEM activities, and exploring the arts.
- Managed successful outdoor events with PTA during pandemic restrictions such as Back-to-School Night, Nature Night, Paint the Plow, Color Run, Jog-a-thon, Turkey Trot, Fall Auction, and 5th grade Pali Adventure Camp field trip.
- Highest attendance rate out of all brick-and-mortar schools in the district.
- Lessened school discipline referrals by approximately 40%.
- Sent kindergarten teachers to the Southern California Kindergarten Conference to increase their ever-abundant knowledge in early childhood educational strategies, and project-based learning curricular activities.
- We beautified our garden through student STEM lessons and teacher assistance.

MPH:

- Assessment Calendars for all core departments (ELA, MATH, SCIENCE, HISTORY) for grades 6-8 prepared to transition to scope and sequence in the 2022-2023 school year.
- 15 MPH EL students reclassified at the conclusion of the 2021-2022 school year.
- MPH PBIS Lion Loot Redemption was at its highest since its implementation in 2016 with over 800 redemptions during the 2021-2022.
- MPH launched a digital statement form to support student reporting, interventions, and overall positive school culture. Access to the digital statement form is available via student bookmarks when students are logged into their district account. The form is also accessible via the MPH website.
- Successful MPH Glow Dance on 05/20/2022 for all students meeting positive criterion.



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RHS:

- RHS has been able to increase mental health services with the opening of the Wellness Center in the Fall. CTE's Health Care and Emergency Services Training Center was built and is being utilized by CTE students, Pre-Med Club students, and currently enrolled EMT students.
- The students are using industrial equipment and are practicing skills and assessments to be at the top of their class. Students are earning Basic Life Support (BLS) health care provider CPR certification.
- RHS won 7 League Championships, which is the most out of any of the 13 schools in the school's conference.
- RHS had a successful WASC mid-cycle visit in which two of the 6 goals were completely met and removed.
- RHS has worked diligently over the last year to develop a teacher leadership team that focuses on data to drive instruction forward.

MHS:

- We received a teacher who taught two periods of science in person on campus for this year.
- Our math teacher is piloting a new Math book/program for purchase and use next year.
- The Mountain Sunrise Rotary taught the Choices program to our students over several days this Spring.
- We sent two students to the Rotary Youth Leadership Academy (RYLA) who have become leaders on campus.
- One of our teachers implemented a new process for parent-student-teacher conferences which was successful in improving student academic performance in most cases.
- Our graduation rate is the highest it has been in 5 years.
- Rim Family Services has been providing group counseling courses on campus two days a week.
- We sent teachers to the Computer Using Educators (CUE) conference, California Continuing Educators Association (CCEA) conference, restorative justice training, and Capturing Kids' Hearts (CKH) training.
- We will be implementing variable credits, work experience, a new student intake process, and establishing a garden this Fall.



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RVA:

- Rim Virtual Academy (RVA) was launched as a TK-12 Independent Study program for ROWUSD students in the Fall of 2021 following the AB-130 requirements of July 2021.
- Two full-time teachers and 14 part-time teachers were hired to deliver textbook and computer-based instruction to a maximum of 130 students and we maintained a waitlist all year.
- The TK-6 teachers coordinated several field trips for their parents and students, including the Big Bear Zoo and Gardenworks.
- The staff secured grant funding to establish a garden and purchase tools to work in the garden.
- The parents were satisfied overall with the program as was reported from surveys through our Kelvin social-emotional feedback software.
